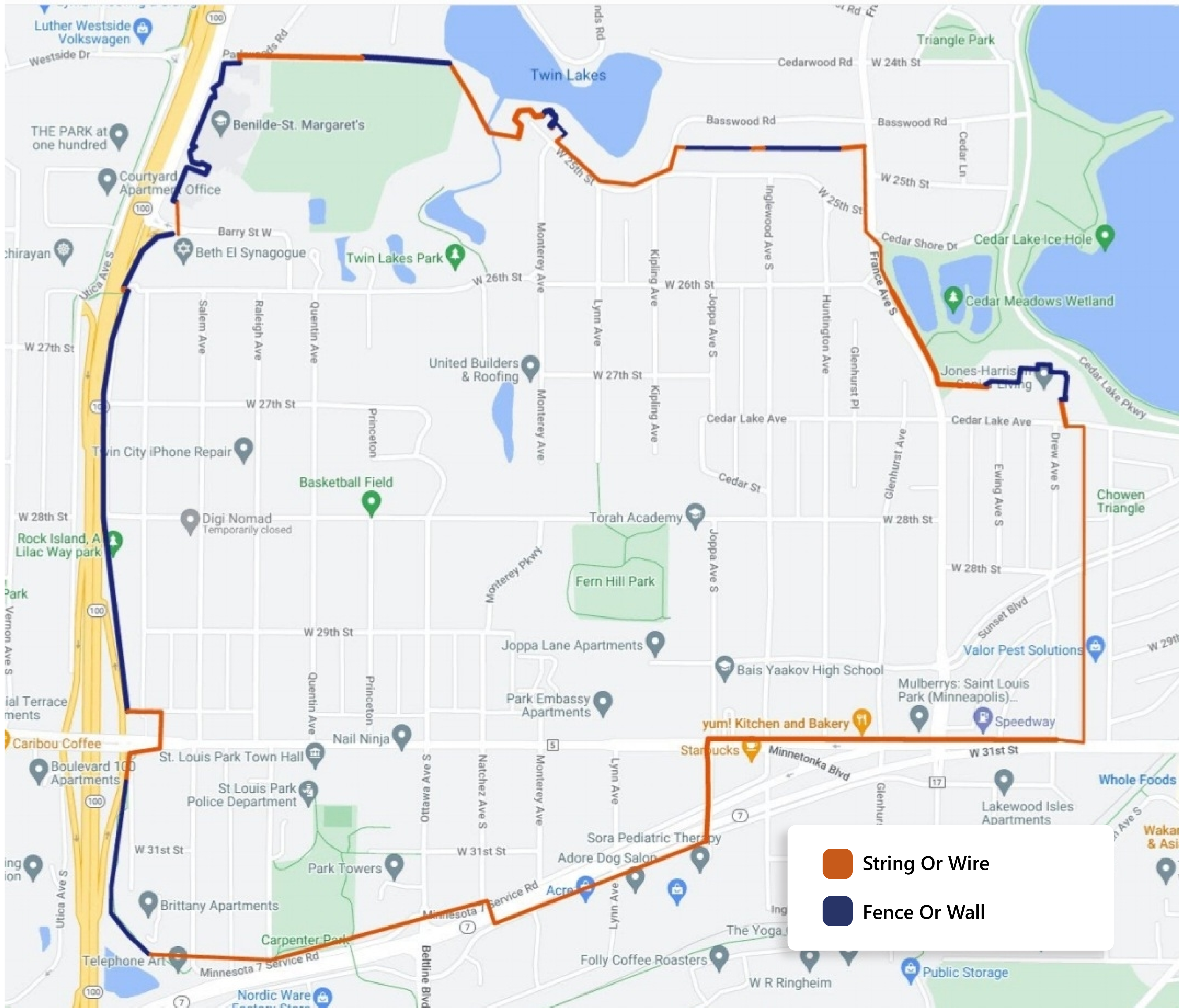


Important Eruv Changes. Please Read!



Please see picture above for an updated Eruv map. (Orange means string or wire, blue means fence or wall.)

Due to the ongoing construction and demolition on 31st St. between Glenhurst Ave. and Inglewood Ave., the Eruv there is still not up. Therefore, the change to the Eruv boundaries is still in effect, leaving out a portion of the southeast corner of the original Eruv, including the apartments at 4015 CR 25.

Currently, Lechis are in place from the corner of Minnetonka Blvd. and the alley of Drew Ave. all the way along Minnetonka, on the north sidewalk, until Joppa. That is the corner right by Darchei Noam. The Eruv then turns south, crosses Minnetonka and meets up again with the existing Eruv on Highway 7 south service road.

Thus, also left out of the Eruv is a good part of the intersection at Minnetonka Blvd. & Joppa Ave., **including the crosswalk at Joppa to cross Minnetonka**, so walkers will need to take care about staying in the Eruv. One must stay on the north and west side of the pole on the Darchei Noam corner to stay in the Eruv. In addition, the southwest corner of that intersection is also out of the Eruv. Although the west sidewalk along Joppa between Minnetonka and Hwy 7 IS included, one would have to stay to the west of the pole on the corner first before getting back to the sidewalk. Please see the attached picture.

Bottom line, anyone with strollers will have to be crossing somewhere west of that intersection. This pertains especially to anyone walking from any of the three Shuls to Yeshiva, the Yeshiva apartments, or anywhere else down Minnetonka.

Also, it would be advisable to NOT walk on Minnetonka between Drew and Joppa until the eruv can be moved back to its original location to make sure no one inadvertently walks out of the eruv.

However, we do have some positive updates. **The cul de sac at the end of 25th St corner Monterey is now back in the Eruv.**

Additionally, on the east end of the Eruv, a **couple of updates were recently completed**, so that the entire Glenhurst alley, Cedar Lake Rd down to France, and the Jones Harrison Home are all now included in the Eruv. Please see the attached Eruv Map for clarity.
